

## Eureka 4th of July Parade

The success of the Eureka 4th of July Parade depends on you, the participants. The following rules will provide a safe and successful parade for entrants and spectators. Thank you for helping us celebrate!

- 1. Every parade unit must complete this form.
- 2. Drivers of all vehicles in the parade must possess a valid driver's license, be at least 18 years old, and possess vehicle liability insurance.
- 3. During the parade, there must not be more than 2-3 car lengths between your entry and the entry ahead of you. Parade Safety Patrol (stationed throughout the route) will ask lingering entries to close the gap. Walkers must keep up with their float/vehicle.
- 4. Careless/reckless driving will NOT be tolerated. No spinning of tires. If you do not comply, Parade Safety will require you to leave the parade route.
- 5. When throwing candy or promotional items, please do not aim at spectators.
- 6. If you have mechanical difficulties or an emergency, please move off to the side of the route so others can move past and Parade Safety can get help to you.
- 7. Any violation of the above rules may result in a ban from next year's parade.

I, the undersigned, accept total responsibility for any and all material(s) included in or on my float, car, tractor, walking group, or other entry. I do not hold the Eureka Business Association, the Eureka Police Department, City of Eureka, or any of its elected officials, administrators, staff members, event workers or volunteers, etc. responsible for any damages, mechanical failures, or accidents occurring before, during or following the 4th of July Parade.
